Subject: Grant of yearly permission to Ayurveda and Unani Tibbia College & Hospital, Ajmal Khan Road, Karol Bagh Govt. of NCT, New Delhi-110005 (Inst. ID UNIO282) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats (13 seats including EWS) in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Munafeul aza - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS), (ii) Ilmul Saidla- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS), (iii) Moalejat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under in respect of appeal-regarding.

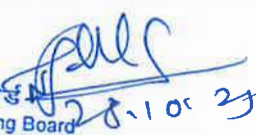
Sir/Madam,

1. This is with reference to an appeal vide ref. No. 5(64)/2025-CO/Unani/17075-1707 dated 15.09.2025 filed by you enclosing an undertaking vide ref. no. F.5(64)/2025-CO/Unani/2158 dated 24.10.2025 submitted by Dr. Yogita Munjal, Director (AYUSH)/HOD(TC), Directorate of Ayush, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Ayurvedic and Unani Tibbia College campus, Karol Bagh, New Delhi to the Commission against the order passed by the President, MARBISM vide letter of even no. dated 20.08.2025 with regards to issuance of permission with seat reduction in UG (BUMS) Course for the academic year 2025-26.
2. In view of the above, the Chairman, NCISM decided to consider the submission made by Dr. Yogita Munjal, Director (AYUSH)/HOD(TC), Directorate of Ayush, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Ayurvedic and Unani Tibbia College campus, Karol Bagh, New Delhi, against the impugned order dated 20.08.2025 passed by the MARB-ISM.
3. Further, a letter dated 27.10.2025 has been received from the Secretary, NCISM and directing the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to grant permission to Ayurveda and Unani Tibbia College & Hospital, Ajmal Khan Road, Karol Bagh Govt. of NCT, New Delhi-110005 (Inst. ID UNIO282) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats (13 seats including EWS) in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Munafeul aza - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS), (ii) Ilmul Saidla- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS), (iii) Moalejat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 as per concerned act and regulations.

"DECISION"

4. Therefore, in view of above, Yearly Permission is hereby granted to Ayurveda and Unani Tibbia College & Hospital, Ajmal Khan Road, Karol Bagh Govt. of NCT, New Delhi-110005 (Inst. ID UNIO282) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats (13 seats including EWS) in 04 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Munafeul aza - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS), (ii) Ilmul Saidla- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS), (iii) Moalejat- 03 seats and (iv) Ilmul Qabalat-wa-Amraz-e-Niswan- 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
5. The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
 - I. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 10 seats (13 seats including EWS) in 04 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters with vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
10. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report shall be submitted to the MARBISM by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Unani) Regulations, 2024.
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
